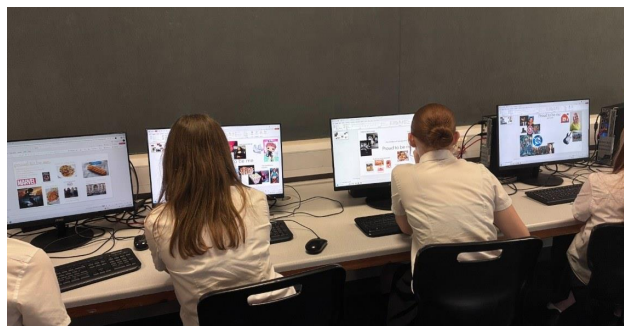


### Proud to be Me

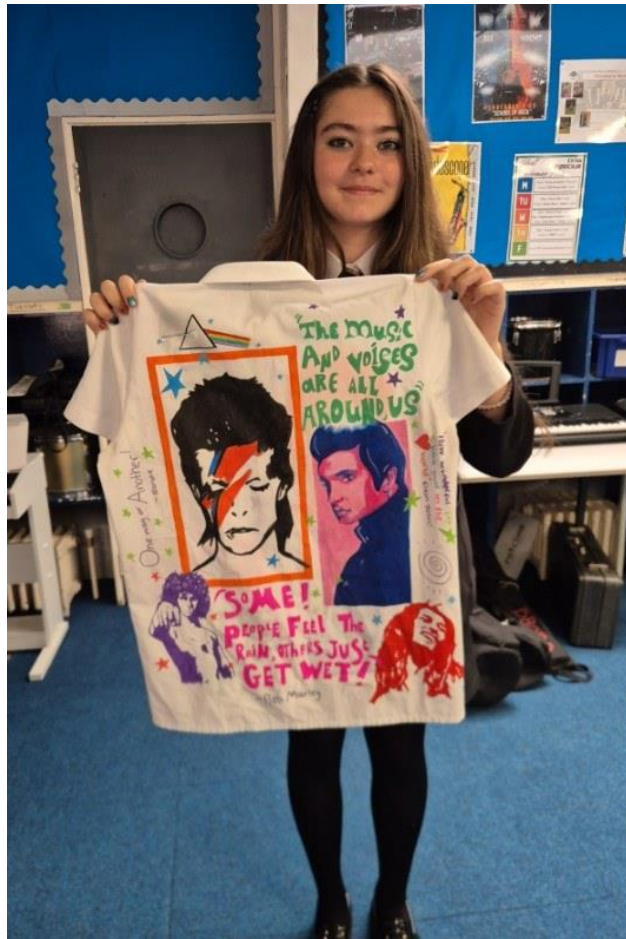
Well done, Year 9! Let's keep up the fantastic standards as we finish the year and carry this positivity and excellent behaviour into Year 10.

## Sixth Form News

### **Are you in Sixth Form and worried about the cost of going to University?**

Mrs Case serves on several local charitable trusts that provide financial support to young people progressing from Idsall Sixth Form to higher education. These charities are dedicated to helping students make a successful transition to university by offering grants to assist with the costs associated with starting student life.

Any student going directly from Idsall Sixth Form to university is eligible to apply for funding. Last night, she met with trustees from the **Shifnal Exhibition Foundation** and all four applicants were successful, each receiving a grant of **£500**. The grants will be paid on **A-Level Results Day**, giving students financial support at a time when they are preparing for their move to university.

The grants can be used in whatever way students feel will best support their transition, whether that is contributing towards accommodation costs during their first few weeks, purchasing essential equipment and course materials, or helping with other expenses associated with beginning university life.

Mrs Case is proud to support these charities and the valuable role they play in investing in the future of local young people, helping them start this exciting new chapter with greater confidence and financial security.

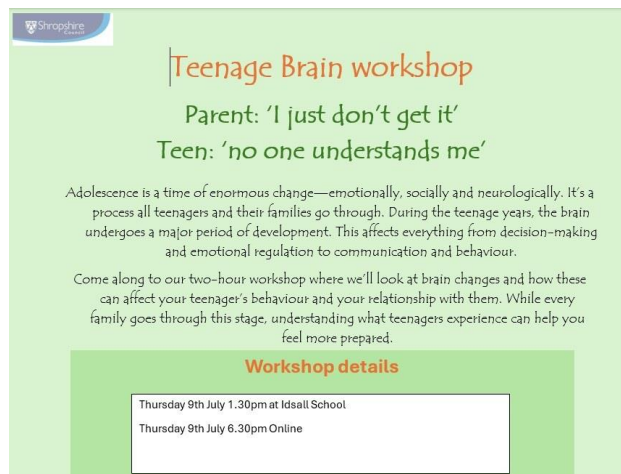

### Teenage Brain workshop

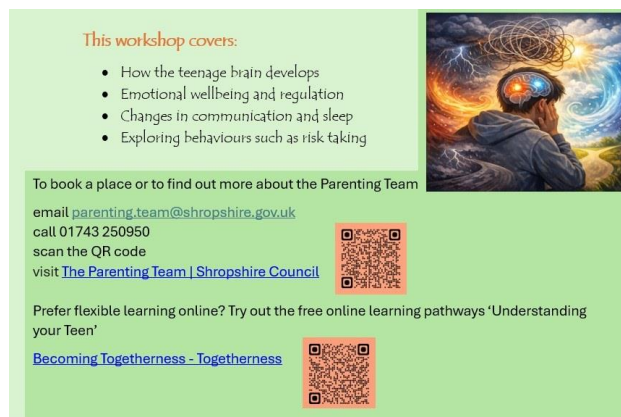
Parent: 'I just don't get it'

### Summer Holiday Fun in Shropshire

Have fun with your friends, learn new skills, gain confidence and get involved!

Shropshire Council is working in partnership to run an exciting holiday programme this summer, Shropshire HAF (Holiday Activities and Food).

Take part in sports, arts, cooking, forest schools and lots more fun activities, happening across the county. Free nutritious meals will be provided at each session.

**There are free places available on the programme for children and young people aged 4 (in reception class or equivalent) to 16, who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals.**

There are a limited number of free places available for children and young people who are not in receipt of benefits-related free school meals but meet a wider eligibility (see [www.shropshire.gov.uk/HAF](http://www.shropshire.gov.uk/HAF) email [HAF.programme@shropshire.gov.uk](mailto:HAF.programme@shropshire.gov.uk) for more details).

### How to Book

Please book spaces directly with the organisations running the holiday clubs from 29 June 2020.

#### What you need to do:

1. Use the electronic **What's On Guide** and searchable **Timetable**, available from 29 June, to find which holiday club is suitable for your children. Electronic copies of the Guide will be sent to you by your children's school and are also available at: [www.shropshire.gov.uk/HAF](http://www.shropshire.gov.uk/HAF).
2. Book onto activity by contacting the organisation running the holiday club direct, using the contact details in the Guide.
3. When making a booking, please quote your unique HAF Code (see box below).
4. If your children has SEND (Special Educational Needs & Disabilities) or receives any extra help at school, before booking onto activity, please contact the holiday club to discuss your child's needs.
5. Any queries you have about your booking or the activities on offer, please contact the organisation running the holiday club directly.
6. If you meet the wider eligibility criteria, please contact: [HAF.programme@shropshire.gov.uk](mailto:HAF.programme@shropshire.gov.uk) for information about referrals onto the programme.

The unique code entitles your children to attend 10 sessions of free holiday activity in Shropshire during the summer holidays 2020. Please don't use this code to book onto more than 10 sessions of activity or to book onto multiple programmes of activity with different providers, happening at the same time.

This code is individual to your child's school and is not transferable to other children. Eligibility checks are carried out on all bookings.

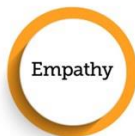
